



Sydney Eye Hospital Foundation OCULOPLASTIC Fellowship

The Sydney Eye Hospital Foundation offers a 12-month Oculoplastic Fellowship, from July to June inclusive.

The Oculoplastic Fellow will work with the following Oculoplastic surgeons:

The Fellow will participate in:

- Four Outpatients Clinics per week (direct patient contact, under supervision)
- 1 - 5 operating sessions per week (direct patient contact, under supervision).
- On-call afterhours for Oculoplastic for the full year (direct patient contact, under supervision)
- Teaching and supervising of our Ophthalmic Registrars/Residents in wards, clinics, operating
- Formal teaching of Ophthalmic Registrars, Nurses, and Wetlab
- Grand rounds and presentations at conference
- Research projects, with publication.

We expect our Fellows by completion of the one-year Fellowship to:

- Complete lid surgery with tumour management and reconstructions. They will be competent to operate independently and supervise ophthalmic registrars
- Complete lacrimal surgery, external and endoscopic procedures
- Complete some orbital cases and assist in surgery for orbital tumours and decompression surgery, with competent use of surgical devices
- Be competent in interpretation of orbital imaging, liaising with other clinical specialties regarding patient care.

The Fellowship is a hospital-based training with a mixture of observation and hands on management of patients through Sydney Eye Hospital, providing a service for our public patients.

We train **fully qualified ophthalmologists** from their respective country of origin.

The successful applicant is chosen based on their level of previous experience, to ensure that they will benefit from the Fellowship being offered, be able to provide a service of high standard to the patients of Sydney Eye Hospital, and are committed to returning to their country of origin with the expertise needed to provide an oculoplastic service.

Applicants returning to public ophthalmology services or academic units will be preferred.
